

Food Chain Vocabulary

Producers- Use sun light, carbon dioxide, air and water to produce their own food (plants)

<u>Primary Consumers</u>- Obtain their energy by eating producers (herbivores); Examples of primary consumers for a rotting log-fungi and bacteria, bark beetles, click beetles, wood borers, carpenter ants, termites

Secondary Consumers — Obtain their energy by eating primary consumers; Examples of secondary consumers for a rotting log-centipedes, daddy-longlegs, wolf spiders, mites, ants, salamanders, woodpeckers

<u>Tertiary Consumers</u> – Obtain their energy by eating secondary consumers; Examples-hawks, owls, raccoons, skunks, and foxes

Scavengers- Consume dead plants, animals, or carrion; break down organic materials into small particles; Examples of scavengers for a rotting log- millipedes, pill bugs, wood roaches, snails, earth worms, mites and slugs

<u>Decomposers</u>- Break down the small particles produced by scavengers; release nutrients back into the soil; Examples of decomposers for a rotting log- bacteria, fungi, insects, earth worms and some snails
