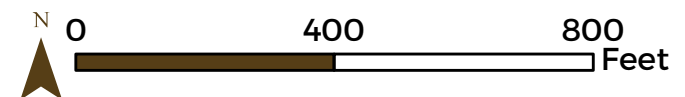
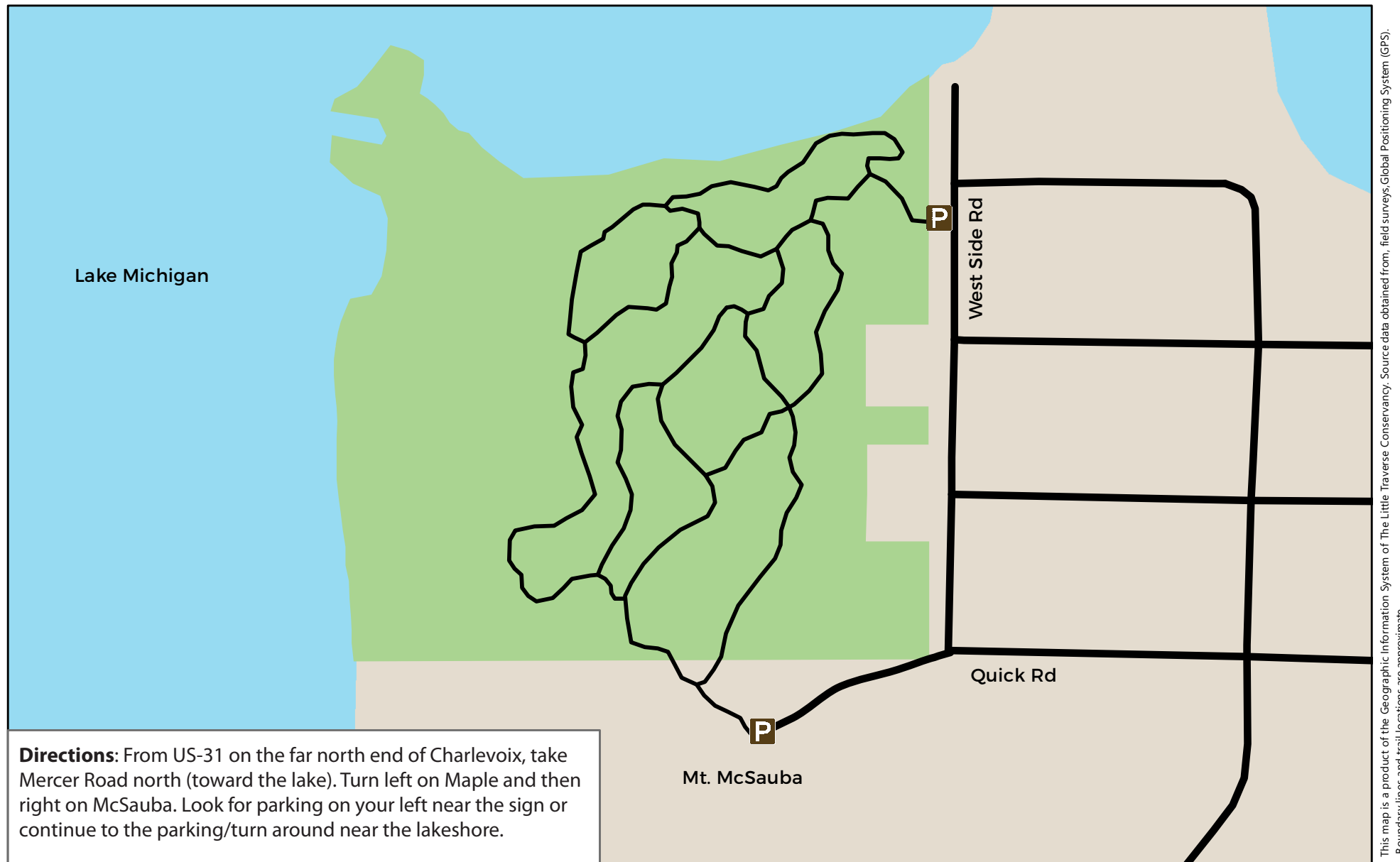




North Point

North Point was purchased with funds contributed by the people and businesses of the Charlevoix area, with the help of a grant from the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund. The land was deeded by LTC to Charlevoix Township as a public nature preserve. North Point not only contains a stretch of undeveloped lakeshore in the middle of this tourist town but three threatened plant species as well: Pitcher's Thistle, Lake Huron Tansy, and Pumpell's Bromegrass.
