



Trail to Preserve Bike Ride

September 16 - 8:30am

Departing from Festival Square, Cheboygan

Ride the North Central State Trail to the Barbara C. Hoffius Nature Preserve (and back)

Join the Little Traverse Conservancy and Top of Michigan Trails Council on a round-trip bike ride to the beautiful 600-acre Barbara C. Hoffius Nature Preserve located northwest of Cheboygan.

Beginning at 8:30 am, we will depart Festival Square (downtown Cheboygan) riding the North Central State Trail to the preserve. We will then park our bikes along the trail to take a short trail walk down to Lake Huron at the preserve. A volunteer will keep an eye on our bikes while we hike to the lake.

This ride will be for 15.5 miles total, returning before noon to Festival Square. While the trail is flat, riders should be prepared to ride this distance comfortably. It is not a ride for young children. Since the path to the shore of Lake Huron includes steps and uneven ground, comfortable walking shoes are advised. Helmets and plenty of water are also encouraged!
