1 Alan and Virginia McCune Nature Preserve

Entering via the Berger Road trailhead, trail markers 1-5 will bring you through .75 miles of trails with a view of the Minnehaha Creek. Once you go deeper into the property, you will find steep grades and rooty uneven trails. The trail markers leading from 4 to 6 have a gentle, but long grade down to the creek and bridge.

2 East Park Resort Township

East Park is managed by Resort Township and offers an ADA-accessible trail and sidewalk that connects to the Little Traverse Wheelway. Here you will find accessible bathrooms, a playground, picnic tables, and a pavilion that sits on a bluff overlooking Little Traverse Bay.

3 Sally & Art Hailand Jr./ Helstrom Family Preserve

A flat wide .75 mile trail system loops through the property (markers 1-4). There are a few slopes as you cross a bridge and the trail has some roots at the beginning. On the Helstrom property you will be led through woods mostly on boardwalks.

4 Headlands International Dark Sky Park

Headlands Waterfront Event Center is equipped with ADA-accessible lit sidewalks that run from the parking area to the building, amphitheater, shoreline, and throughout the designated night sky viewing area.

5 Jones Landing Bear Creek Township

This ADA-accessible park features a covered pavilion, restrooms, picnic area, playground, boat launch, restroom facilities, and a sandy beach. There is an ADA-accessible sidewalk that leads to the water.

6 Seberon "Boo" Litzenburger Nature Preserve

In 2024, the upper trail of this preserve is just under a half mile loop and will have crushed aggregate leading to a viewing platform overlooking Five Mile Creek and the lower trail. The lower trail is only accessible by hiking down a very steep incline.

7 Offield Family Viewlands Lower Trail and Labyrinth

From the lower parking area, you will find over a half mile of barrier free crushed aggregate trail and reflection labyrinth created in partnership with Bluestem Meadow. Trails past the labyrinth are paved, but are very steep.

8 St. Ignatius Church Beach Friendship/Readmond Township

A very short trail leads to an ADA-accessible overlook of Lake Michigan. There is also access to the beach by stairs. NOTE: North of Church Beach on Lamkin Drive is Readmond Township Park. Here you will find additional access features, including beach access via a beach mat.

9 Round Lake Nature Preserve

This one mile flat trail loops through a mixed hardwood and conifer forest. The trail leads out to an overlook platform and bench at Round Lake.

10 Spring Lake Park Bear Creek Township

Spring Lake Park is complete with over a half mile of ADA-accessible trail and boardwalk overlooking Spring Lake. Restrooms, a pavilion, and enclosed fishing platform are also available. This trail also connects to the Little Traverse Wheelway and the North Western State Trail.

11 Thorne Swift Nature Preserve

Nestled on Lower Shore Drive, Thorne Swift is an ever popular preserve. The Cedar and Pond Trail is a one mile loop, somewhat rooty, but flat and wide, leading on and off boardwalks through multiple habitats, and eventually stairs to Lake Michigan. Balsam Trail has steep slopes and a lake overlook platform.

12 Waldron Fen Nature Preserve

The trail leading south into the pine trees is flat and will take you around the fen for an almost 2 mile hike. If you follow the trail to the east, between trail markers 1 and 2, you will find steeper sections and more roots than the rest of the preserve. Dogs are not allowed at this preserve due to nesting birds.

13 Watson Nature Preserve

The inner loop of this preserve is almost a half mile trail and will take you on a single narrow trail that has some gentle slopes and roots. The outer loop includes more slopes.

14 Charles M. Taylor/Olstrom Family Nature Preserve

A wonderful half mile hike out to Lake Charlevoix is offered at this preserve. Note that the trail gets somewhat rooty when you get out to markers 6 and 7 in the cedar forest just before the lake.

15 Camp Sea-Gull Hayes Township

Camp Sea-Gull is managed by Hayes Township, with access to Lake Charlevoix for fishing, boating or just taking in the view. Recent updates have been made at this park to create an ADA-accessible dock for fishing. There are no trails at this park.

16 Don & Eileen Klein Trail/Rogers Family Homestead

In partnership with the City of East Jordan, this fully ADA-accessible half mile trail connects the City of East Jordan to LTC's Rogers Family Homestead Preserve, which is Flat and Barrier Free. An additional mile can be found at the Rogers Preserve which is natural ground and flat, but varied terrain.

17 St. Clair Lake Six Mile Lake Nature Preserve

Visitors can enjoy a universal access trail (the Mary Behrens Sorrell Trail) for people of all ages and abilities. The preserve includes one mile of undeveloped shoreline and is excellent for canoeing and kayaking. The natural area has a small parking area and a rustic canoe/kayak launch.

18 Duncan Bay Nature Preserve

This preserve offers a one mile flat path to the shores of Lake Huron, just west of Cheboygan State Park, where an overlook platform is found. Gentle ramps lead on and off of the boardwalks and bridges.

19 Hildner-Bearce/Waubun/Davis Family Nature Preserve

About a mile of trails offers a classic Up North hardwood forest hike in close proximity to Burt Lake. Starting at trail marker 5 you will find a steady grade leading to marker 4, but taking the loop in the opposite direction, to number 3, will offer you a gentler uphill hike.
